Indirect proof

2-column proof vs. Indirect proof

2-column proof

- Done in a 2-column format
- Start with the given statements
- Proving a statement directly

Indirect proof

- Done in a paragraph format
- Start with the prove statement
- Getting a contradiction of an assumption

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Indirect Proof Procedure

1. List the possibilities for the conclusion.
2. Assume that the negation of the desired conclusion is correct.
3. Write a chain of reasons until you reach a contradiction.
4. State the remaining possibility as the desired conclusion.
